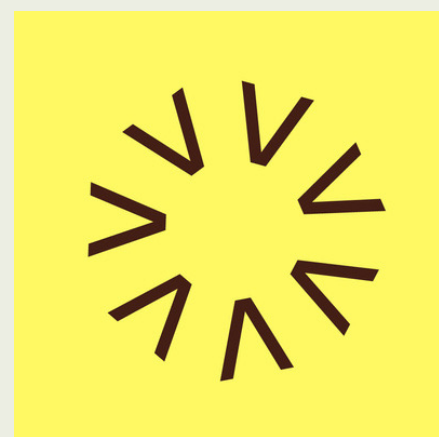
Bath Arts Collective, is a community interest company that drives, develops and contributes to a collaborative, vibrant and varied arts & events scene in Bath and surrounding areas.

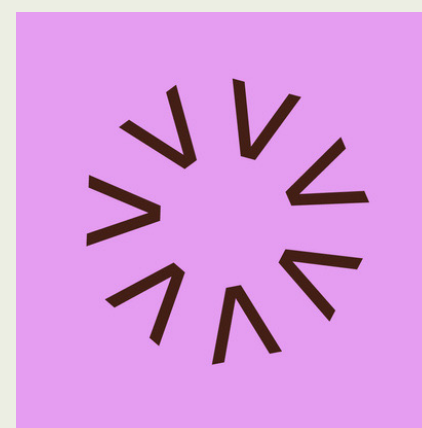

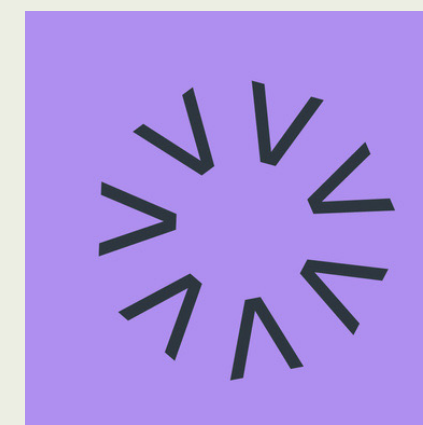
